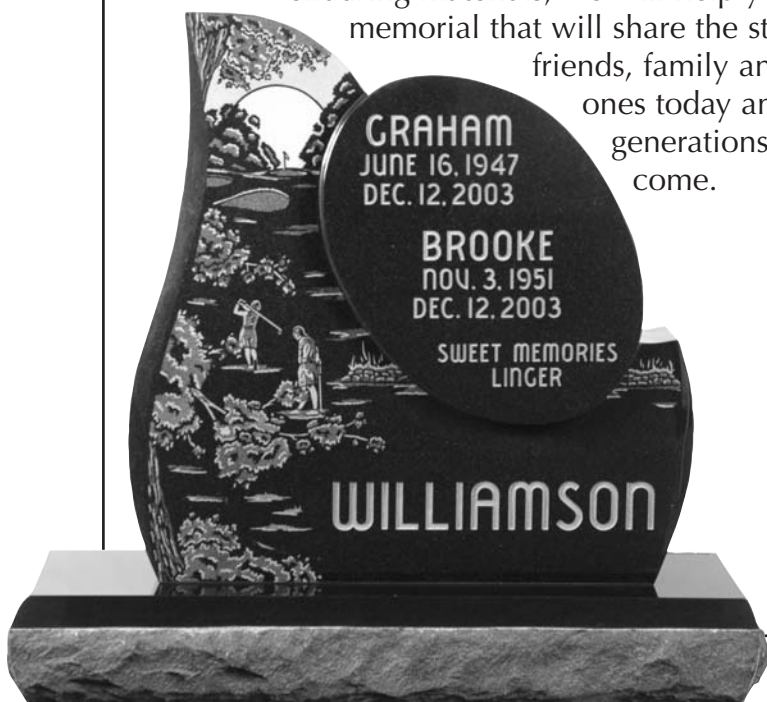

## Remembering Interests and Passions

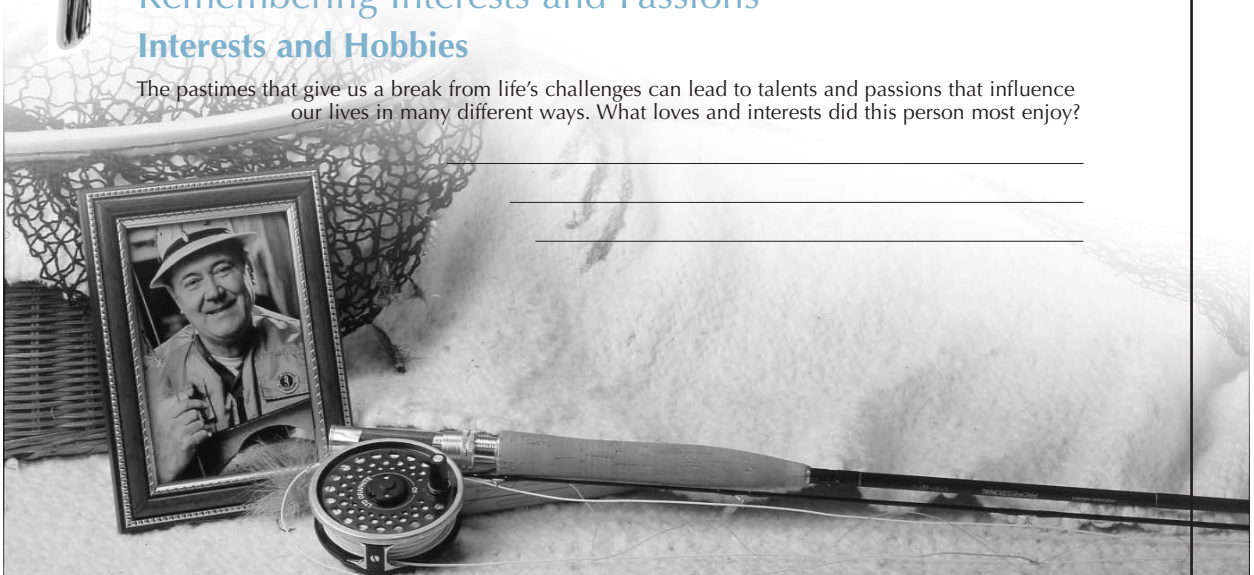
### Interests and Hobbies
